

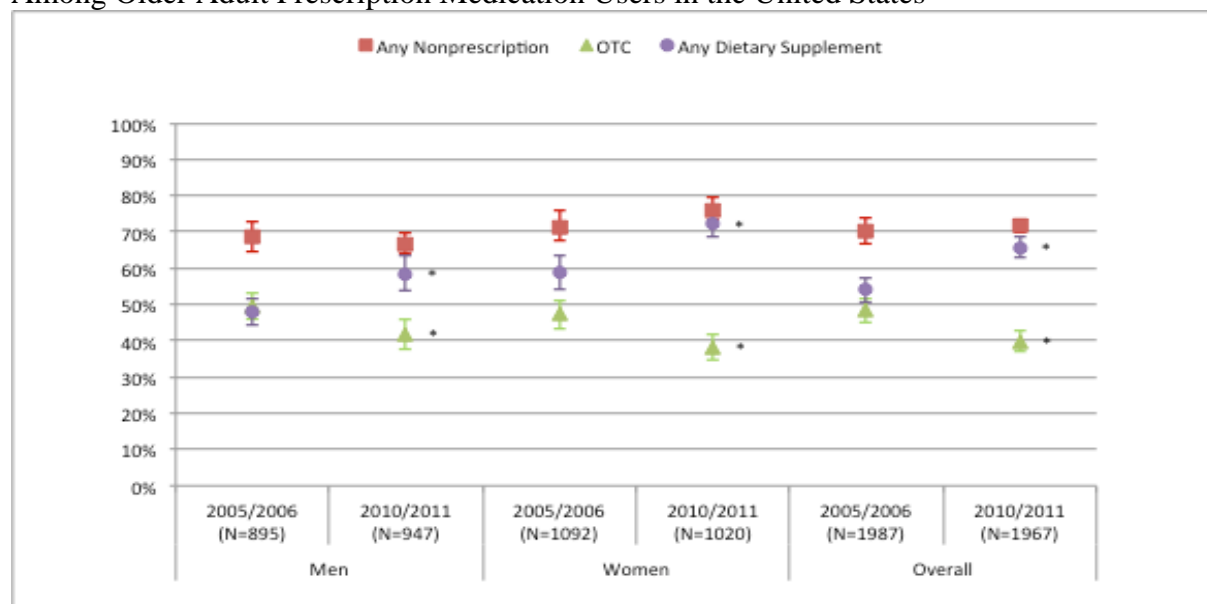

Error Bars indicate 95% confidence intervals; P-values are based on a Wald test of the predictive margin calculated by averaging the age-specific differences in predicted prevalence (on the logit scale) between waves over the observed ages in the sample, and using a design-based estimate of variance. \*p-value < 0.05.
